Mayor Mike Cornell lets everyone know that the plumbing and electric inspection are coming back to the City of Riverview, transition is projected to take approximately 1-2 weeks. Budget for 2025-2026 has been approved by the Missouri State Auditor, this must be done every year in July. Riverview is the 1st municipality to have its courts closed, then reopen, a city can't survive off of the General Fund alone, we need that revenue from the courts to keep rebuilding our City. Additionally, we have been pre-approved for a grant for approx. \$300,000.00 to \$700,00.00 to build a park in the area. This should have been done with the money that was received by the previous administration of \$700,000.00 that no one wants to talk about. But we are here to rebuild our community and move forward.

Adjournment: With no further business to discuss, Mayor Cornell adjourned the meeting at 7:21pm


